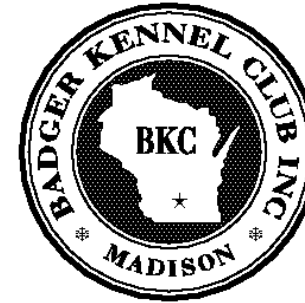

Each additional obedience entry of the same dog per day:

\$19.00

(For example, if "Rover" is entered in Open B on Saturday, the entry fee is \$24.00. If "Rover" is ALSO entered in Utility B on Saturday, the entry fee for Utility B is \$19.00. "Rover's total entry fee is \$43.00. If "Rover" is entered in both Open B and Utility B on both days, the total entry fee is \$86.00.)

(For example, if "Rover" is entered in Novice B on Saturday, the entry fee is \$24.00. If "Rover" is ALSO entered in Novice B on Sunday, the entry fee for Novice B is still \$24.00. "Rover's" total entry fee is \$48.00.)

ENTRIES CLOSE: Thursday, November 12, 2009 at 5:00 p.m. unless the numerical limit is reached prior to the closing date after which time entries will not be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted.

Entry fees must accompany all entries. Make checks or money orders payable to **Badger Kennel Club**. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. An official AKC entry form must be used. Sorry NO fax or email entries will be accepted. **If using overnight delivery, please sign signature waiver.**

Bitches that come into season after the closing date will have the entry fee less \$5.00 refunded upon written certification by a licensed veterinarian to the effect that the bitch in question is in season on the day of the trial. **NOTIFICATION MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE TRIAL SECRETARY BEFORE 8:00 AM (CST) ON THE TRIAL DATE.**

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judges, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the trial giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE

AKC recording fees and Event Service Fees are required for each dog entered at any licensed or member obedience trial or rally trial. These fees are included in the entry fees collected by the show-giving club. The show-giving club forwards the fees to the AKC. For details of the fees required by the American Kennel Club, please see the *Regulations Applying to Dog Shows*, Chapter 11, Section 2, as well as the *AKC Rally Regulations*, Chapter 1, Section 3.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From North (Fond du Lac/Green Bay): Take Hwy 151 to I90/94 north of Madison. Go west on I90/94 to Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From West (Wisconsin Dells): Take I-90/94 toward Madison. Exit at Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From South (Janesville), take I-90 north toward Madison. Exit at Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From East (Milwaukee): Take I-94 to I-39/ I-90 West toward Wisconsin Dells. Exit at Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From Hwy 51 South Exit: Go south on Hwy 51 to first stoplight (CTH CV/Anderson Road) and turn left. **Look for the colorful water tower.** Turn left on Haase Rd. then take the fifth (5th) driveway on the right-hand side on Haase Rd. The BKC Training Center is located on the north side of the parking lot. **Be sure you are on Anderson Road, not Anderson Street.**

Anyone witnessed not picking up after their dog will be excused from the trial with no entry fees refunded.

AGREEMENT

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by the negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees, agents, or any other persons. I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTERPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2 The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3 (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.
4 A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
