**October 8, 2015**

**Meeting called to order at 7:02**

**Judy moved to approve minutes, as amended, (removal of the “(5)” from the end of the minutes) from September. 2nd by Deb. Motion approved.**

**President’s report:** there is a free metal desk (in training center) and old mats on the back loading dock that are free for the taking.

**Vice President’s report:** Received an inquiry about a discount plan for training treats, but forgot to bring treats along for evaluation. Board didn’t want to endorse one brand over another, ask if interested in a dog fair booth.

**No secretary’s report.**

**Treasurer’s report:** Budget items presented via e-mail, and what to do with CD?. Judy stated that we will have a better handle on cash needs after the Dog Fair; the Dog Fair was tabled until November’s meeting. The remainder of the budget items were passed, with the exception of acquisition of a large TV or computer.

**Members will be voting in November on changes to By-Laws to reflect the P and P changes.**

**Dog Fair:** breeds are filling, most of gate positions are filled.

**Dunbar seminar had 6 members attending, and are starting to implement info gained from attending the seminar.**

**New Business:**

**Small Dog play group has inquired about using facility, would meet 1 time per month, and charge \$2/dog. Bryan suggested that the small group rate would fit this type of use (\$20/ hr.).**

**A Volunteer is needed to post pictures of various dogs in classes to Facebook, and to ask people to “Like”.**

**Hortonville Drama club was looking for a “Toto” dog, and has been addressed (contact given to them)**

### Minutes of the Board of Directors Meeting

November 12, 2015

The meeting of the Badger Kennel Club Board of Directors was called to order at 7:00 p.m. on Thursday, November 12, 2015.

**Present:** Lynda Nelson, Bryan Conrad, Judy Donmoyer, Tammy Jackson, Pat Smith, Wes Brown. A quorum was present.

Bryan Conrad made a motion to approve the Minutes of the October 15, 2015 Board meeting. Tammy Jackson seconded and the motion carried.

**President's Report:** The President reported that she had been contacted by DCHS about doing a presentation over school break similar to what BKC had done this past summer. She will be looking for volunteers to assist. Samantha Dennison applied to AKC to be a canine ambassador. Judy Donmoyer commented about the recent Dog Fair, relaying comments made to her by people attending the event. Brief discussion followed.

**Vice President's Report:** Storage of mats was discussed. There was discussion concerning protection of the new matting at the training facility during trials and events. Discussion followed. A building maintenance summary was also presented.

**Secretary's Report:** The Secretary reported receipt of delegate notices from AKC. She will pdf and forward to Judy Corbett, the AKC delegate for BKC.

**Treasurer's Report:** A full treasurer's report was not available, as the Treasurer was not in attendance. There was discussion about the Edward Jones account and the BKC CD. Judy Donmoyer made a motion to invest \$20,000 of BKC funds in a short term CD. The motion was seconded by Wes Brown. There was additional discussion, followed by a vote. The motion carried. The AT&T bill went up. There was discussion about whether BKC really needs a land line. This issue will be brought up for discussion at the next general membership meeting to obtain member input.

**Old Business:** Amendment of the Membership portion of the Bylaws was discussed. Judy Donmoyer made a motion to accept changes to membership section of Bylaws. The motion was seconded by Bryan Conrad, and carried.

Karen Albright has been looking for replacement for Karen Johnson's classes, and found Missi Roland for the winter session, as well as some additional classes prior to the end of the year. Gary Garbe has agreed to teach in the spring. Tammy Jackson made a motion to authorize Karen Albright to negotiate contracts with Missi Roland and Gary Garbe for the classes. Judy Donmoyer seconded, and the motion carried.

**Dog Fair Update:** Net income for the 2015 Dog Fair was up over the prior year. (\$10,000+ compared with \$6,400 the prior year.) Dog Fair photos will be put up on Facebook.

A prospective member addressed the Board and answered questions concerning her application. Discussion followed. Judy Donmoyer made a motion to bring the application to the general membership for vote. Wes Brown seconded, and the motion carried with one Board member voting nay.

Steve Paschkiewicz addressed the Board concerning the Dog Fair, requesting authorization to begin negotiations with the Alliant enter for the 2016 Dog Fair. Discussion followed. Judy Donmoyer made a motion that Steve be authorized to begin negotiations with the Alliant Center. Tammy Jackson seconded the motion, and it carried.

Judy Donmoyer made a motion to adjourn. Pat Smith seconded, and the motion carried. There being no further business before the Board, the motion was adjourned at 9:50 pm.

**Agility:** 1 class running right now, Wednesday novice class 4 dogs, classes will restart the second week of January, all classes will be available. Agility trial is almost full for both days, over 300 on Saturday, Sunday 280. Vendors at the trial December 12 and 13th. Special treats are available. Photographer will be there. Still need volunteers for grunt work. C match Friday November 20. Trial starts Saturday morning. Baked goods needed.

**Conformation:** 8:00 advanced classes, starting in January there will be a beginners class again (looking for an instructor for this), no class week of Christmas and New Year's.

**Puppy:** Full Nov STAR class, openings in Dec Basics & STAR

**Therapy:** classes just ended. Went to Blackhawk technical college, police department. New classes will start up in February. At dog fair there were 7 teams taking part in the pet education program. Next year that will be part of the program as well

Advertising, hospitality for refreshments to judges table, gate help, \$35 a night for overnight RV parking/cost prohibitive?, 3 days of national owner handler series, junior showmanship all 3 days, Sunday there will be Wisconsin top handler, judges are all lined up. Handling Ring on Friday most likely after best in show – practice ring you have to pay for. The fairground has upped their prices a bit causing profit margin to be decreased. The entry fee this year will be \$27.

## Treasurer's Report

December 2015

I would first like to thank those volunteers who did an awesome job in organizing and working the Dog Fair, Obedience/Rally and Agility Trial. I heard positive comments from the public in how much they enjoyed the events.

Also, I want to thank those members who has been patience with the treasurer as I had three events to work on. We had three great fundraising events that kept this treasurer very busy these past two months.

Tasks done this past month or so.....

- Paid BKC Property Taxes - paid \$196.58
- Down payment for Jefferson Fairgrounds for 2016 May Show – paid the first payment of \$4,000
- AKC membership fee paid
- Down payment for Alliant Center for next November – paid the first payment of \$1,000
- Income/Bills for Dog Fair (and volunteered)
- Income/Bills for Obedience/Rally Trial (and volunteered)
- Income/Bills for Agility Trial (and volunteered)
- Checked PayPal for payments for classes – have seen increase of usage
- Received checks in mail for classes – and informed secretaries of these payments
- Checked and monitored our Edward Jones account (as of 12/31/2015 - \$29,448.74)
- Paid AKC fees for March 2016 obedience/trial
- 2014 990 Returns done

Income/Expenses and Misc.

- Rent will increase this upcoming year back from \$3820.66 to \$4075.09 per contract agreement
- Our class income increased from last year. We saw an increase of \$3,479 from last year – 22% increase
- We are down in fundraising from last year (est. \$900)
- We have seen increase of those who are interested in joining as new members
- We are down (\$133) in run-thrus
- We saw an increase in revenue for trials. A big part is due to having our 1<sup>st</sup> agility trial in 10 years. But ALL three trials did a good job.
- Our event operations was up from last year, but this is due to holding an addition trial and equipment rental.
- Our utilities bills are down due to the warmer weather. It is down \$300 from last year.

We have seen a nice increase in interest in our classes and trials. Keep up the good work! Again, thank you to those who have helped out in our special events, but also to those who help in running BKC.
