Bitches in season the day of the trial will be tested at the end of the trial. The Trial Secretary must be notified in writing no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the trial.

Entry fees shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from the competition by action of the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the trial giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SHOW SITE

From North (Fond du Lac/Green Bay): Take Hwy 151 to I90/94 (north of Madison). Go west (north) on I90/94 to Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From West (Wisconsin Dells): Take I-90/94 toward Madison. Exit at Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From South (Janesville), take I-90 north toward Madison. Exit at Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From East (Milwaukee): Take I-94 to I-39/ I-90 West toward Wisconsin Dells. Exit at Hwy 51 South, exit #132.

From Hwy 51 South Exit: Go south on Hwy 51 to first stoplight (CTH CV/Anderson Road) and turn left. Turn left on Haase Rd. then take the fifth (5th) driveway on the right-hand side on Haase Rd. The BKC Training Center is located on the north side of the parking lot.

(For those coming North on Hwy 51 from Madison - Be sure you are on Anderson **Road**, not Anderson **Street**.)
